

Nulhegan Confluence Hut And Trails Map and Directions



The hut is off Route 105, about 2.6 miles west of Bloomfield, Vermont, and 13.5 miles east of Island Pond, at the confluence of the Nulhegan River and it's East Branch. **Coming from the west:** Take Rt. 105 from Island Pond. After ~10 miles, you will pass the Nulhegan Basin Visitor Center. The road will descend a hill, cross the river, and then descend another hill. The property is the large field to your right. If you cross another bridge, you've gone too far. **Coming from the east:** From Bloomfield, take Route 105 west for 2.6 miles. You will pass over the East Branch of the Nulhegan River. The East Branch Road will be on your right. The property is on your left.

It is about a 300 yard walk to the hut. During the summer, park along side the road. Look for a mowed path leading down to the site, past a kiosk. During the winter, park at pull off just down from the East Branch Road. Bring a shovel and snowshoes. Look for a lock-box on the porch with a key.
